

HOUSE RULES

1. We treat each other **courteously and respectfully**. We solve problems with words – not with violence. In an emergency, we seek help from an adult.
2. We acknowledge that **all humans are different but of equal value**. We fight against discrimination. Nobody may be disadvantaged on the basis of their gender, descent, skin colour, body features, religious or non-religious beliefs.
3. We don't destroy or make dirty the premises and the **property** of the school or the after-school care (tables, toilets, materials etc.) or the property of our classmates. Parents and legal guardians are liable for their children.
4. We leave cell phones, smartwatches and any other **electronic devices** at home (exception: toy day at the after-school care). If we choose to bring devices anyway, neither the school nor the after-school care are liable in case of damage or loss.
5. We arrive at school **on time** and say goodbye to our parent or carer in front of the school. If a legal guardian wishes to discuss any matter in the school, they should register at the secretary's office.
6. During the teaching period and after-school care, we may only leave the **school grounds** with permission.
7. We wear **slippers**.
8. Within the school and after-school buildings, we behave **quietly**. We do not scream, run or cavort.
9. We do **not chew chewing gum** and we do **not drink energy drinks**.
10. While **lunch** is served, we wait in line. We take our time to eat and leave our place clean.
11. Our **homework notebook** and **mail folder** are controlled on a daily basis by our legal guardians. They sign notifications straight away.
12. We bring home our **sports bag** on Friday and our swimming togs on Thursday.
13. If we are missing something, we search for it independently. The lost-property office is open on Friday from 6 am till 4 pm. **Lost property** will be brought to the foyer at least two times a year.
